Who can be nominated

Any apprentice who has completed their qualification, at any level or discipline, between 1st August 2025 and 31st July 2026 and is either Kent and Medway based or has a Kent and Medway based training provider. We do take delayed EPA and ESFA certification into consideration.

Who can nominate apprentices

Applicants can be nominated by their employer, apprenticeship provider. Self-registration can only be via request using our contact form. Applications will be verified. Places are available on a first come, first served basis so recommend early registration from 1st March 2026.

When nominations are made it's essential that all parties involved, apprentice, employer and provider are informed. Registration closes noon, 1st August 2026. Graduates will be required to complete their gown bookings before 1st September or places will move to our waitlist.
