Any apprentice who has completed their qualification, at any level or discipline, between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022 and is either Kent and Medway based or has a Kent and Medway based provider can be nominated.

Who can nominate apprentices

Applicants can be nominated by their employer, apprenticeship provider or can self-refer in exceptional cases. Applications will be verified and places are available on a first come, first served basis. When nominations are made it's essential that all parties involved, apprentice, employer and provider are informed.
